## Mahoning County Jury Finds Youngstown Man Guilty of Attempted Murder

YOUNGSTOWN, Ohio (Thursday, May 19, 2022) – Mahoning County Prosecutor Paul Gains announced today that a Mahoning County jury found Luis Johnson, 24, of Youngstown, guilty of attempted murder from a shooting incident that occurred in October of 2020.

Jurors found Johnson guilty of several charges:

- One Count of Attempted Murder with Firearm Specifications ---A Felony of the 1<sup>st</sup> Degree
- One Count of Felonious Assault with Firearm Specifications ---- A Felony of the 2<sup>nd</sup> Degree

On October 12, 2020, Tevin Gregory was shot multiple times outside of an apartment on Fairfax Street. Gregory told police that someone in a Burgundy Lincoln shot him; he sustained gunshot injuries to his right wrist and abdomen. Officers spoke to several witnesses who described the scene of the crime. Once officers from Youngstown Police Department located and searched the vehicle, they obtained a warrant for the arrest of **Luis Johnson** and **Tyree Robinson** for attempted murder. A few days following the shooting, Johnson turned himself over to the US Marshal Service at his mother's house. Robinson turned himself in to the Youngstown Police Department shortly after finding out that he was wanted for his role in the shooting.
